Students should collect pay-in-slips from the said banks after payment and bring them to the University. **The University will not accept cash payment.**
- Attachment fee will be paid by students required to undertake attachment as specified in the syllabus, usually at the end of an academic year. Affected students will pay **Kshs. 6,948/=** per annum.
- Money for books and food are estimates for student's use and is therefore not paid to the Institute.

**NB:** (i) **Fees is paid up front. Those unable to do so could pay 50% of Tuition fees and 100% of other charges on registration, and to clear the balance during the semester, and not later than the 12<sup>th</sup> week of the semester.**
