1. Students should collect pay-in-slips from the said banks after payment and bring them to the University. **The University will not accept cash payment.**
2. Attachment fee will be paid by students required to undertake attachment as specified in the syllabus, usually at the end of an academic year. Affected students will pay Ksh. 2,895/= per annum before the attachment.
