ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Authors are expected to have completed the research by the time of the Conference
- Abstract must be 300 words or fewer, but not less than 100 words. The Abstract should be single spaced, A4 page size, 12 fonts size and written in Times New Roman.

- Indicate the names of all authors and indicate the name of the author presenting the paper.
- Include the name of the Institutions and complete contact of the author.
- Abstract should be preferably submitted in Electronic format or hard copy send/delivered to the Conference Secretariat at ITROMID office at JKUAT.
- Abstract should use the following headings;
 - TITLE
 - AUTHOR
 - OBJECTIVES
 - METHODS
 - RESULTS
 - CONCLUSION

FULL PAPERS SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- **Ethical Considerations**
Any author whose manuscript is associated with a study on humans must supply evidence that the appropriate Ethics Committee was satisfied and approved the study. The study itself must provide information in detail on how the consent was sought and received from the study subjects or their caregivers in the case of children.
- The corresponding author should ensure that the details of the co-authors are provided as follows: names, qualifications, designation and current address (es) including email.
- *Original articles and Reviews:* Should be between 3000 and 4000 words, with a maximum of four tables or other illustrations. Original articles should present data and information from original research.
- References should not exceed 30 for original articles. For original articles, results and discussion should be presented separately.
- The manuscript should be in the following format:
 - Title
 - Authors names and addresses
 - Abstract (not more than 300 words)
 - Introduction
 - Methodology
 - Results
 - Discussion
 - Acknowledgement
 - References (Harvard Style)

The manuscript should be double spaced using Times Roman 12 point's font size
