- i) Complying with the Energy (Energy Management) Regulations, 2012 and other legislation relevant to energy use
- ii) Committing budgetary and other requisite resources towards energy management
- iii) Ensuring the use of energy efficient processes and equipment
- iv) Maintaining a sound maintenance schedule of all energy-consuming equipment
- v) Enhancing staff competencies in energy management through regular training
- vi) Inculcating a culture of energy efficiency and conservation amongst all stakeholders, through regular training and sensitization
- vii) Continuously monitoring the energy use patterns in the University with a view to identifying areas for improvement
- viii) Continuously seeking and implementing green energy alternatives as much as is practicable

This policy shall be reviewed every four years or as necessary.
