**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR PARTIAL FELLOWSHIPS
MASTER DEGREE RESEARCH ON WATER IN UPPER TANA BASIN**

RE-ADVERTISEMENT

The Water Research and Resource Center (WARREC) of JKUAT received some funding support from The Nature Conservancy (TNC) to implement the research component of the Upper Tana- Nairobi Water Fund (UTNWF) Project. WARREC is implementing this project in collaboration with the Nairobi City Water and Sewerage Company (NCWSC) and the Water Resources Authority (WRA).

As part of research support and capacity building, this project is supporting a total of 15 Master research projects with **partial fellowships** of which **six (6)** are being issued in this call. The project supports only the research work (not tuition) for projects relevant to water management issues and implemented in the project area, and which will be approved by the Project Management Committee.

Interested Master degree students who have completed and passed their coursework are encouraged to apply. Applicants are free to identify a first supervisor for their project from their respective departments. This is a partial fellowship to support only the research work for a limited duration.

The minimum requirements for Applicants:

- Bachelors degree in Soil and Water Engineering, Water and Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science or related field.
- Should be registered and pursuing a Master degree course in a recognized university in Kenya
- Should have completed first year Masters degree coursework and passed
- Should be self-motivated and committed to quality scientific research.

Application deadline and requirements:

Candidates are encouraged to submit their applications by **hand delivery** to the Office of the Director Water Research and Resource Centre (**WARREC**) based at **JKUAT**, by **28th February, 2019, 17.00 hrs.** The application should include:

- 1) Letter of application.
- 2) Letter of recommendation from the Chairman of Department where candidate studies,
- 3) A Concept Note of the Proposed Research in the project area (not more than 3 pages)
- 4) A Curriculum vitae of the candidate.
- 5) Master degree results transcripts for the first year coursework.
- 6) Bachelor's degree Certificate and university transcripts.
