



International Women's Day (IWD) Celebration

Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology-Women in Information Communication Technology (JKUAT-WICT) in collaboration with the Youth for Technology Foundation (YTF) will mark this year's International Women's Day by hosting a mentorship workshop on **March 8, 2019 at Assembly hall, JKUAT Main Campus**. The event takes place from **9am to 3pm**.

The event, whose 2019 campaign theme is *#BalanceforBetter*, aims to inspire women to take up leadership roles, empower women through technology, and promote gender balance. The event, that brings together the JKUAT Gender and Monitoring Centre, JKUAT student clubs such as Society of Engineering Students (SES), Society of Computer Science and Information Technology (SCOSIT), the Institute of Electrical & Electronic Engineers (IEEE) and high school female students mentored by JKUAT and YTF, will consist of mentorship sessions, technology workshops and ignition talks.
