<b>BSc. in Physiotherapy (Direct entry)</b>	Applicants must have a mean grade of at least C+ at K.S.C.E. or its equivalent, with at least a “C+ “in the subject clusters indicated. <b>Alternative A:</b> Biology and Chemistry, Mathematics or Physics, English or Kiswahili <b>Alternative B:</b> Biology Sciences, Physical Sciences, Mathematics, English or Kiswahili Or - K.A.C.E 2 or more principals with one in Biology and in Chemistry.
<b>BSc. in Physiotherapy (Upgrading program)</b>	Diploma in Physiotherapy from a recognized Medical Training Institution or its equivalent as recognized by JKUAT. <b>Or</b> Diploma in Physiotherapy, with Higher National Diploma in Health related program recognized by JKUAT. In addition, the candidates <b>MUST</b> be registered with Physiotherapy Council of Kenya (PCK). Foreign trained Therapists must be registered with their respective professional associations in their respective countries of training. They must also be compliant with the Physiotherapy Council of Kenya (PCK) requirements. <b>(Part Time on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays)</b>
<b>BSc. in Occupational Therapy (Direct entry)</b>	A mean grade of at least C+ at K.S.C.E. or its equivalent, with at least a “C+ “in the subject clusters indicated. <b>Alternative A:</b> Biology and Chemistry, Mathematics or Physics, English or Kiswahili <b>Alternative B:</b> Biology Sciences, Physical Sciences, Mathematics, English or Kiswahili <b>Or</b> - K.A.C.E 2 or more principals with one in Biology and in Chemistry.
<b>BSc. in Occupational Therapy (Upgrading program)</b>	Diploma in OT from a recognized Medical Training Institution or its equivalent as recognized by JKUAT senate. <b>Or</b> Diploma in OT, with Higher National Diploma in Health related program recognized by JKUAT. In addition, the candidates <b>MUST</b> be registered with the Kenya Occupational Therapists Association (KOTA). Foreign trained Therapists must be registered with their respective professional associations in their respective countries of training. They must also be compliant with KOTA requirements. <b>(Part Time on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays)</b>
